Quick Summary



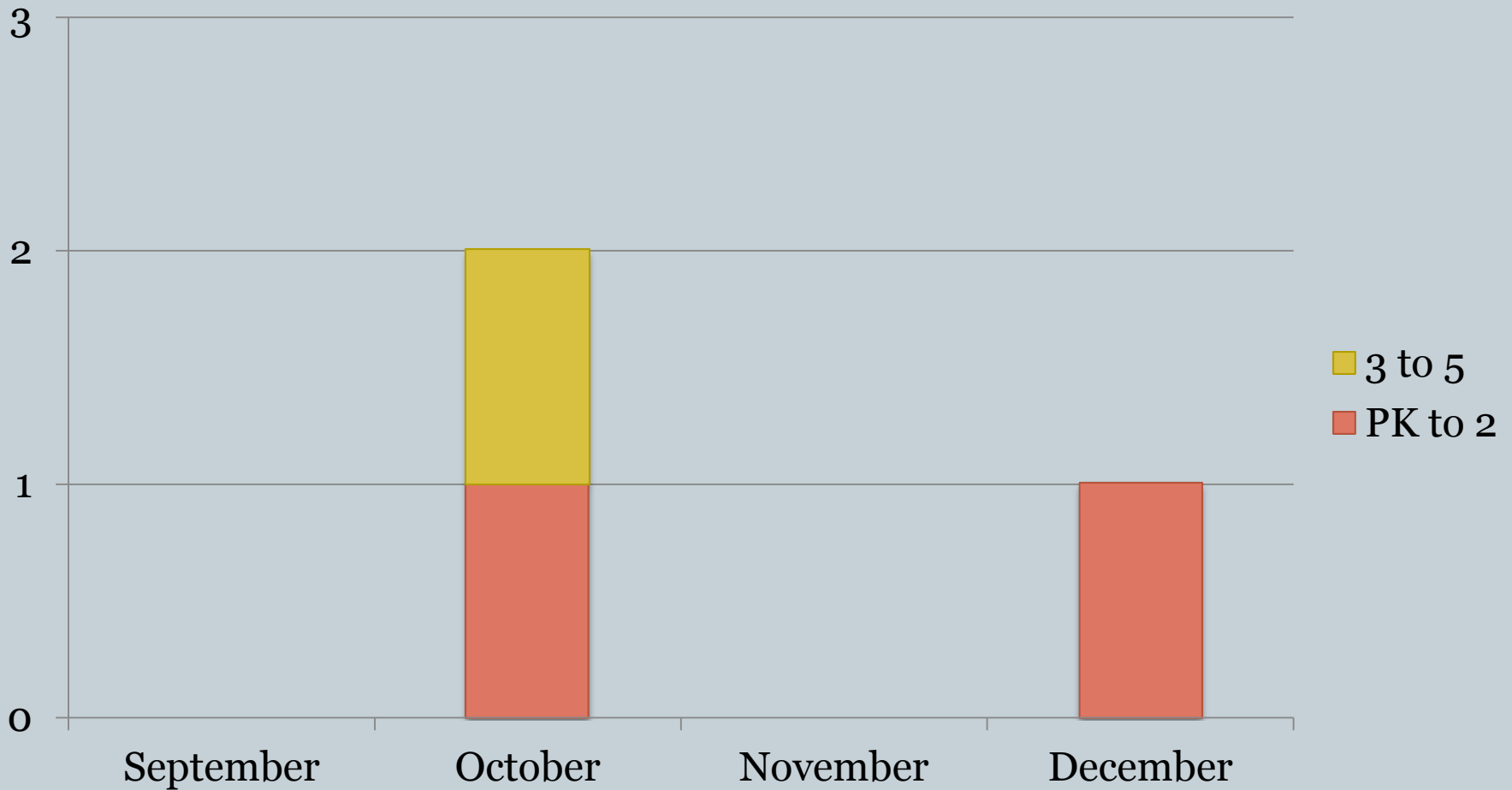
- There has not yet been an incidence of substantiated HIB in grades PK-5 this school year.
- There has been a major decline in HIB incident reports at Lafayette school at this point in the school year as compared to last year (1 v/s 8). We believe this is a result of the newly adopted Responsive Classroom approach in grades PK-5, as it allows students to start their day discussing their feelings, and supplies consistent positive behavior support and conflict mediation throughout the school day.

What we are doing now

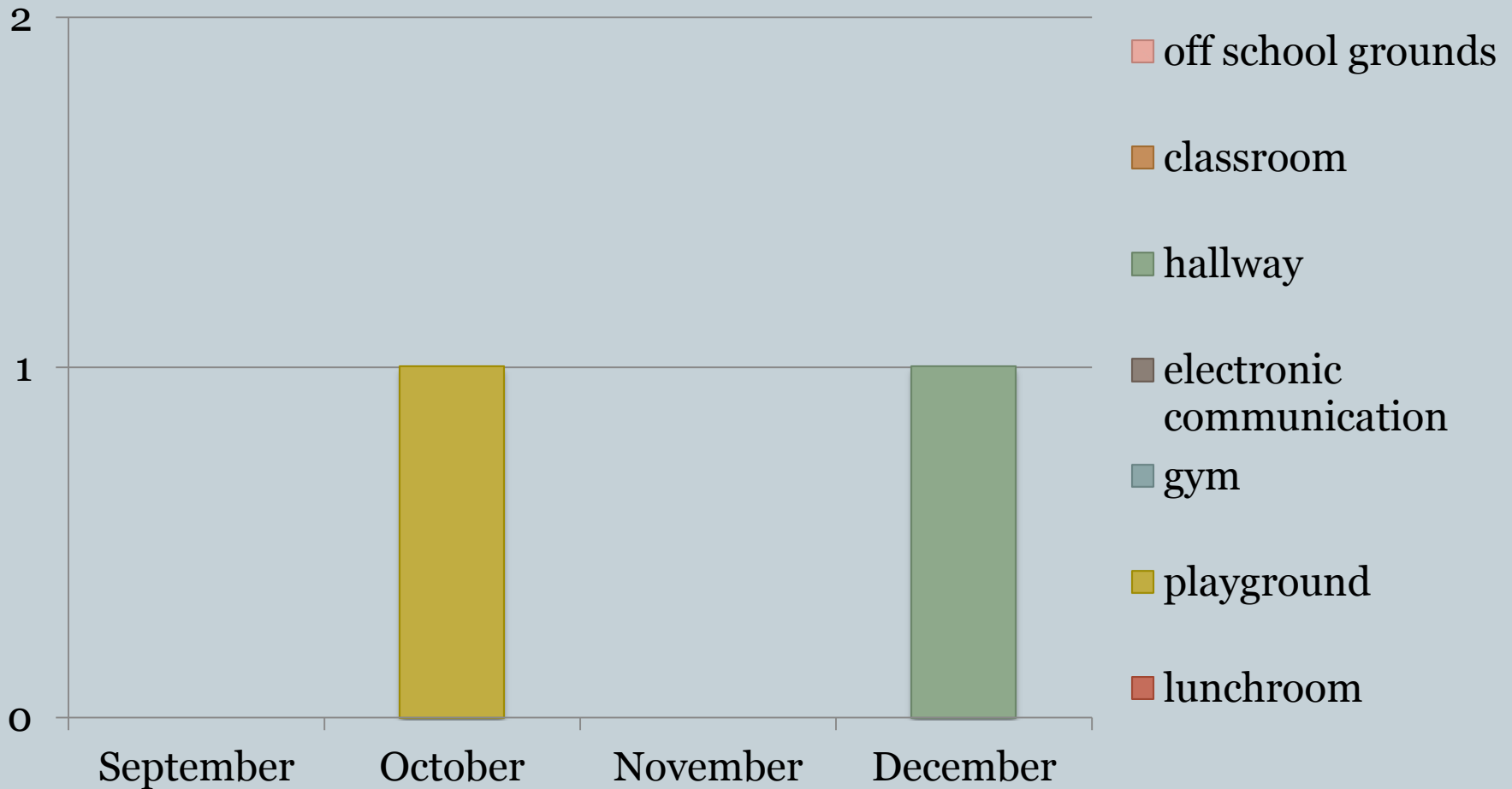


- Responsive Classroom approach fully implemented in grades PK-5
- Character Ed / Anti-bullying Curriculum (Josephson Institute) taught weekly in grades PK-2
- Enrichment period created at Lafayette allows classroom guidance delivery to all classrooms without impeding on specified educational time; all activities at enrichment time (music, art, clubs, etc.) serve to reinforce student self-confidence and positive interactions
- Safety Patrol program in grades 3-5, leadership and character education a focus of the program
- Peer Mediator program started for 5th graders to act as leaders in positive conflict resolution among their peers and for students in grades 3 & 4
- Lunch groups focusing on preventing bullying and social skills in PK-2
- 6 week Bully-Busting curriculum for grades K-5
- Transition and buddy groups for new students in PK-2

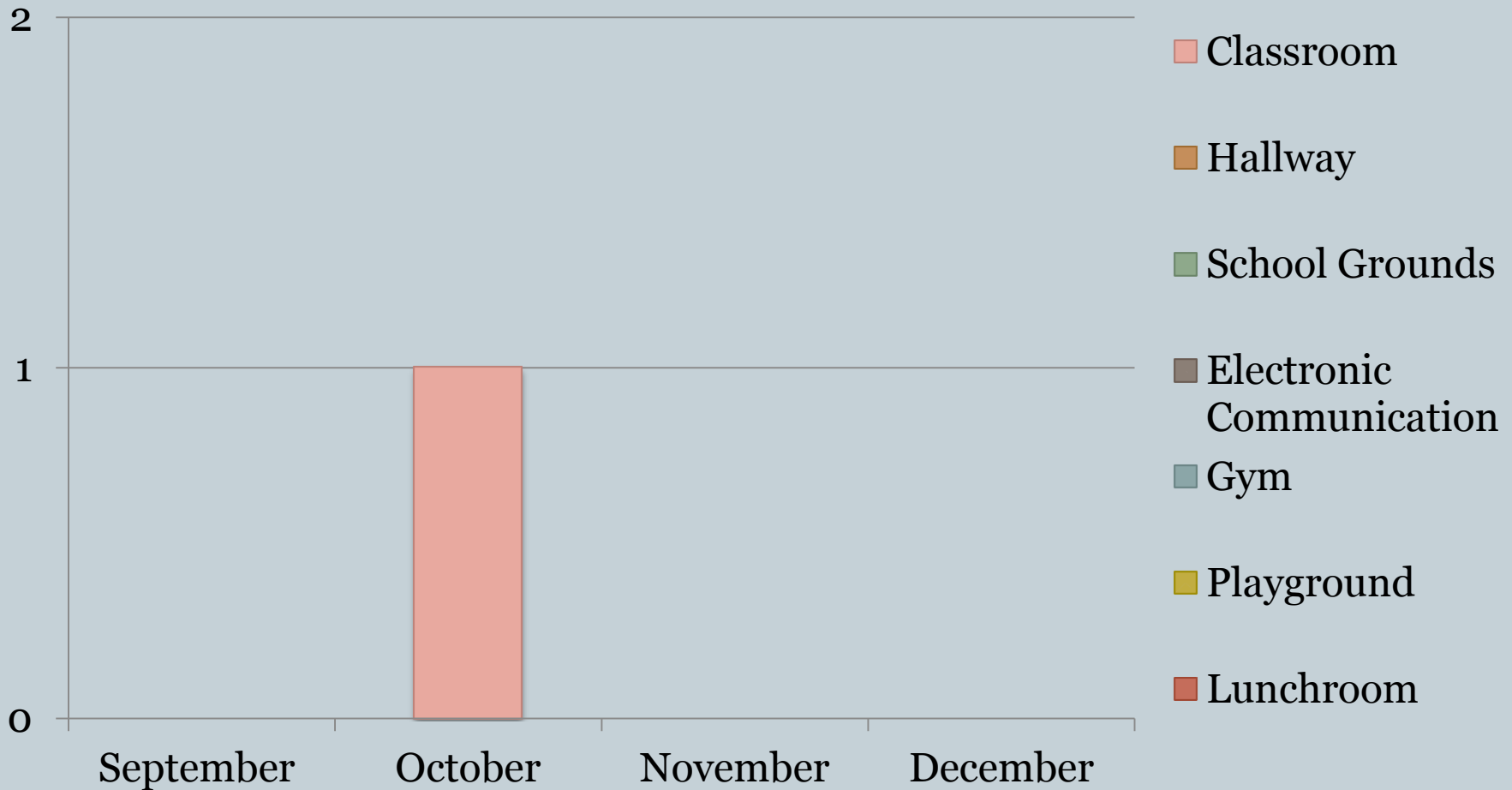
Incidents by Month



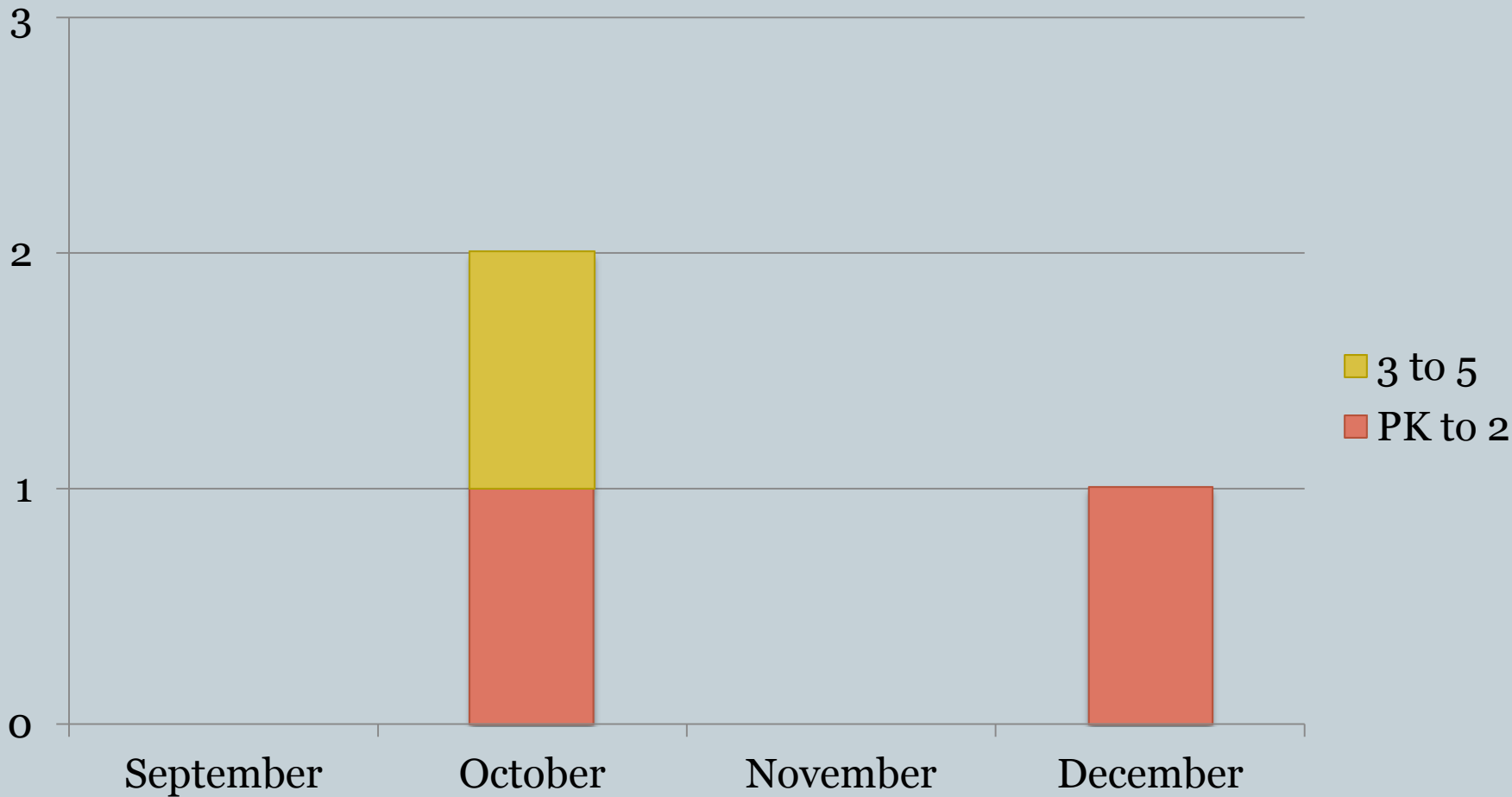
Location of Incident: LaMonte & Annex



Location of Incident: Lafayette

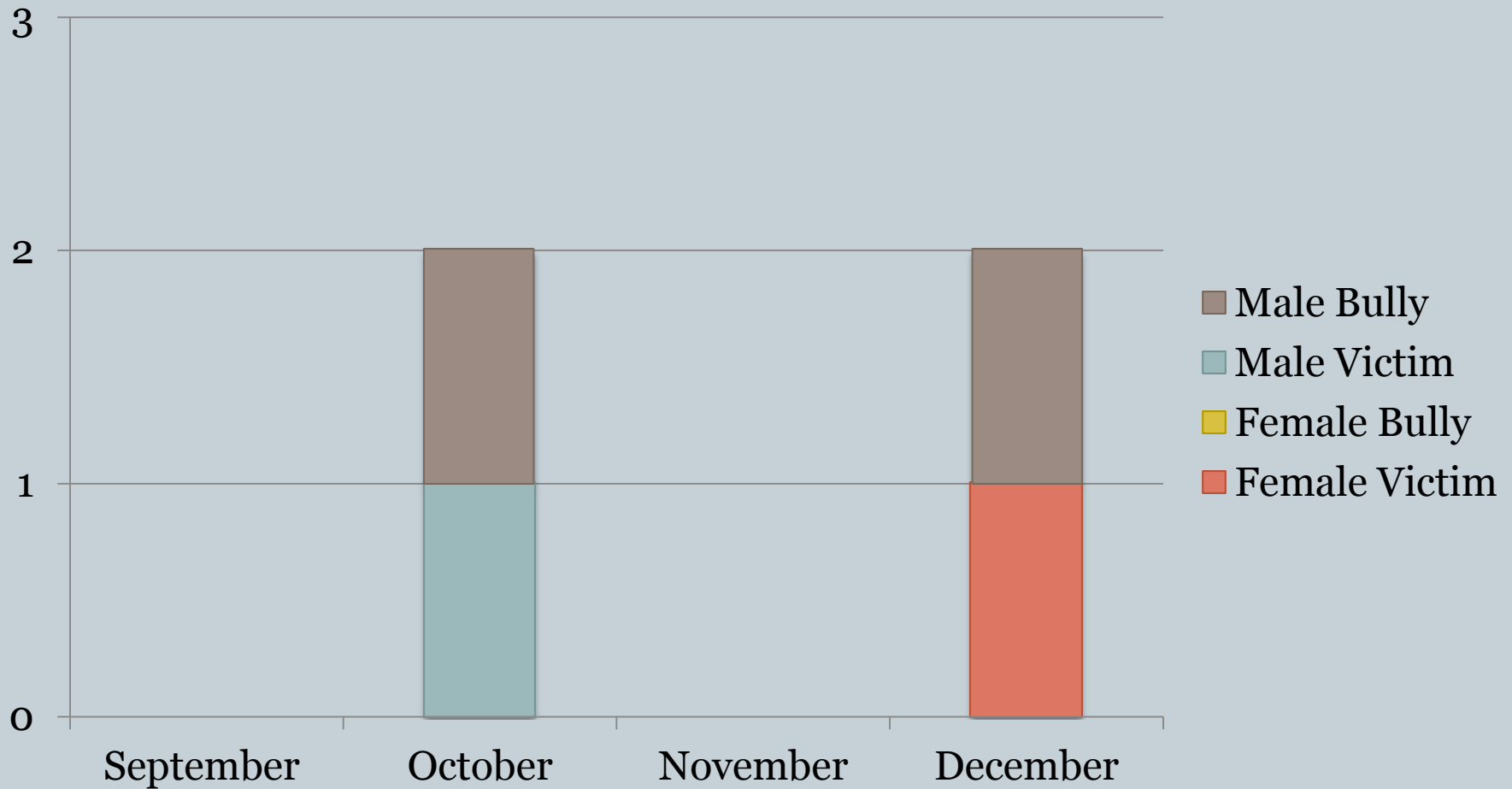


Incidents of Conflict (Not HIB)

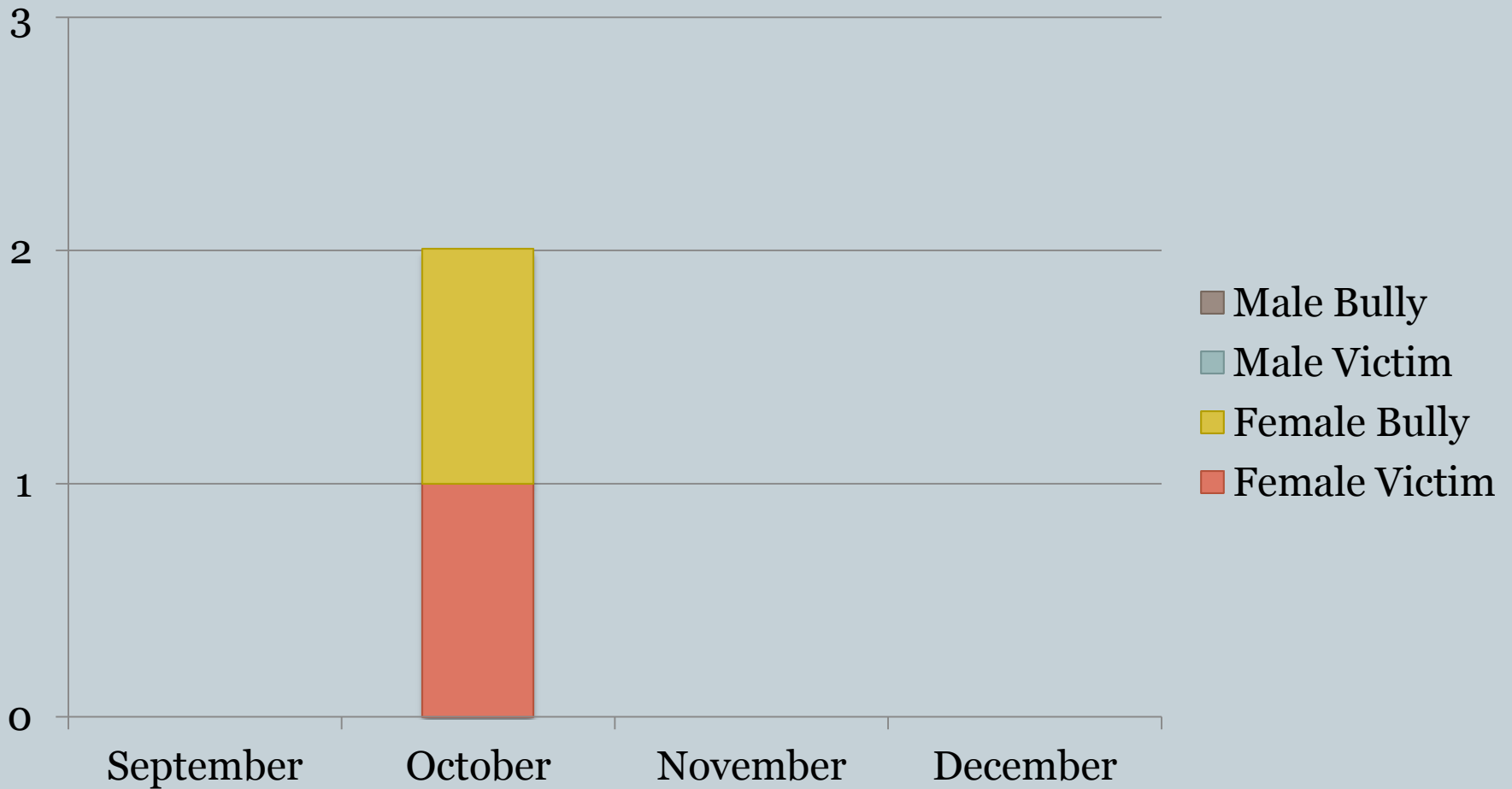


Gender of “victim” v/s Gender of “bully” in Conflict

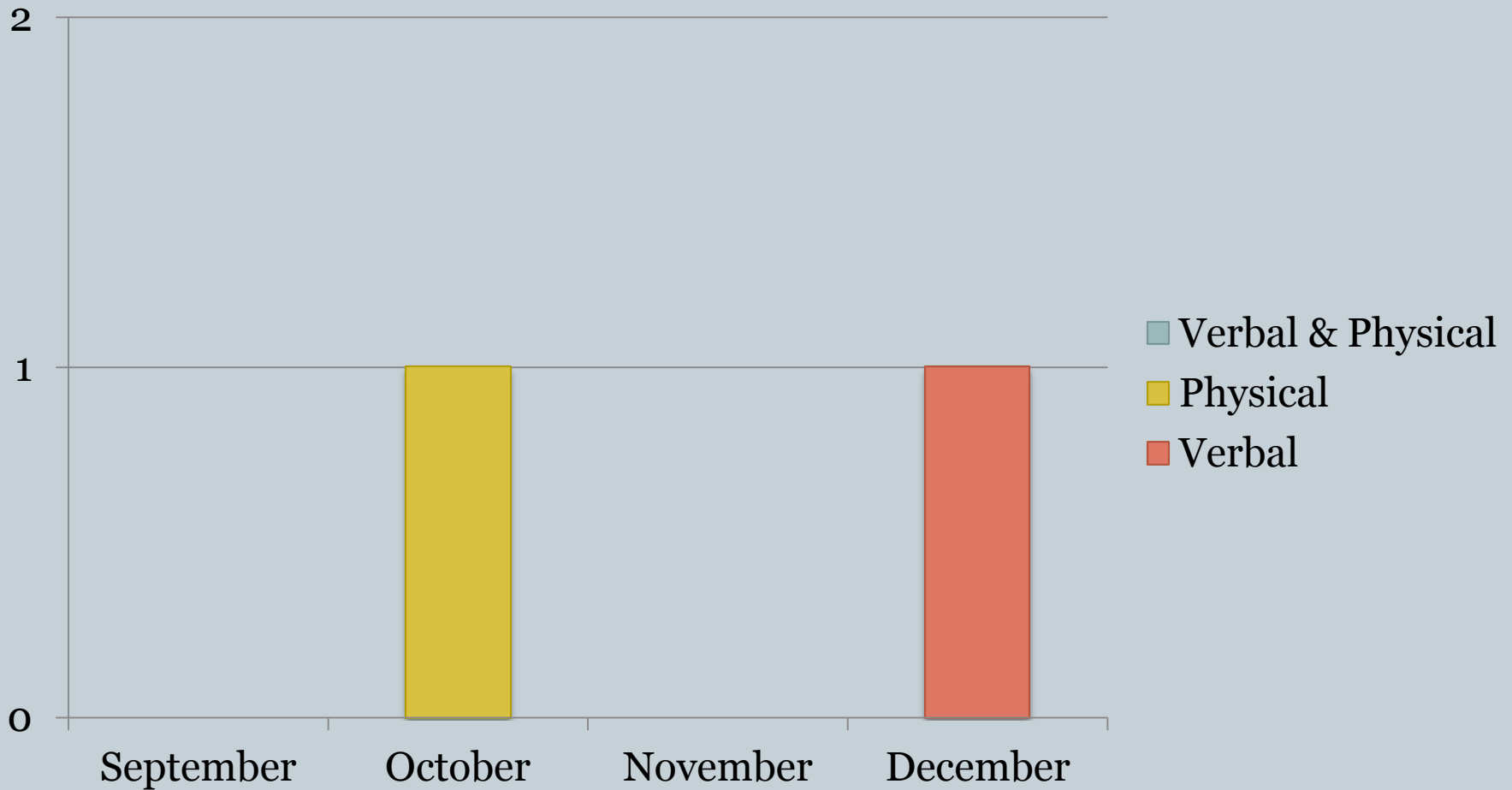


Gender of “victim” v/s Gender of “bully” in Conflict *Lafayette*
